

Food Distribution Volunteer at MCC Needed

Third Thursday Each Month

Axis Community Health is a nonprofit community health center. We are the Tri-Valley's only provider of health care for low-income and uninsured residents. Our services include medical care, dental care, mental health counseling, and a WIC nutrition program.

Axis is partnering with the Alameda County Food Bank and MCC-East Bay to distribute food to Axis patients in order to improve nutritional health. We are looking for volunteers to assist with this project. Volunteers will help at our monthly food distribution for 3.5 hours (from 10:30am to 2:00pm) on the third Thursday of each month at the MCC-East Bay in Pleasanton.

Qualifications:

- 1. A positive attitude and willingness to assist clients.
- 2. Prior volunteer experience not required.
- 3. Must be age 18 or above.
- 4. Ability in more than one language welcome, but not required.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Learn about the set-up, distribution activities, and safety practices during event preparation.
- 2. Complete assigned tasks at each distribution, e.g., table set up, unloading of food, client interaction, recording of data, clean up and storage.
- 3. Coordinate your schedule and availability each month with the Volunteer Coordinator.
- 4. Commit to a minimum of three months of service.
- 5. Complete an Axis Volunteer Application and agree to background check.
